Challenges and Solutions: We'll discuss the challenges businesses face in this process change and how to navigate these challenges.

Objectives

- To share relevant laws, regulations, guides, FAQ on specific industries, and catalogues issued by the Inland Revenue Board (IRB) in Malaysia related to e-invoicing. This includes documents outlining compliance requirements, tax implications, and standards for e-invoicing

- Case studies on creating e-invoice / Self billed e-invoice / Employee claims
- Outline of the key tasks to carry out the process change for the company

At the end of the training the Finance / HR / IT / Procurement / Sales teams will be aware of the concept and the requirements to comply with e-invoice implementation in Malaysia. They will understand the tasks needed to implement e-invoice adequately within the deadline imposed by IRB.
